## **Attitudinal Effects on the Welfare of Livestock throughout the Value Chain**

### Public

- Reasons for attitudes towards husbandry/management practices and animal welfare in the livestock industries, and therefore, what can be done to address these attitudes
  - Attitudes towards husbandry practices (limited in some industries)
  - Attitudes towards alternative husbandry and management practices
  - Effect of repeated adverse events on public attitudes, knowledge and trust
- Strategies to address public attitudes, knowledge and trust
  - Understanding transparency and trust
  - Comparisons between public and producer attitudes and perceptions
  - Changing community attitudes and behaviour: learnings from other fields, such as health/medicine
- On-going monitoring of public attitudes, knowledge and trust
  - Sampling methodology

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## **Attitudinal Effects on the Welfare of Livestock throughout the Value Chain**

### Producer/stockperson/animal handler

- Attitudes towards husbandry and management practices and animal welfare (*considerable research on handling*)
  - Attitudes towards alternative husbandry and management practices
  - Understanding barriers to adoption
  - Transport
